## Livin' the J10 LIFE

## SUNDAY A.M.

Sunday morning for J10 is all about Jesus. We want to show the world a Jesus that

## SMALL GROUPS

Sunday a.m. is just the tip of the iceberg for J10. Sunday a.m. is only 10% of who we are. In our small groups you get to experience the other 90%. Our small groups are where people get a chance to connect with others. At J10, we believe an integral part to living our fullest life is being "with". With others, with friends, with family, with church. Don't live life alone. Live it WITH others. Small groups are designed to be WITH others. Below are different types of small groups we offer.

### LIFE GROUPS

Life Groups offer a chance to connect with 10-12 others in the living room of a "J10er". Something sweet or salty is always involved as well as a great discussions from the sermon, a bible verse, or chosen topic. These groups are mixed (men, women, married, or single). ### D-GROUPS

D-Groups are perfect fit if you're looking to develop a consistent time in the Bible (but just don't know where to start)! We'll provide the 2 things you need to succeed: 1.) a plan 2.) a group of friends to encourage you. Groups of 3-6 meet one hour each week. ## OTHER GROUPS

**INFINITY GROUPS** - Is there something you enjoy doing? Do you have a passion to get people together for a specific interest or project? One of the best ways to connect is through our passions.

**SPECIAL EVENTS** - A few times a year we gather the whole J10 family for an event. These events range from a picnic, prayer gathering to a community outreach event.

**SUNDAY LUNCH** - Every Sunday a group of "J10ers" head out to a local restaurant to eat, hang out and connect with each other. Check out the program to see where we are eating each week.

**MINISTRY TEAMS** - Our greatest desire is to connect people to Jesus and their J10 life. Every week there are about 50 "J10ers" that ascend on Broad Run High School to set up and prepare the Sunday am environment. At J10 our expectation is that all "J10ers" will be apart of these teams. We will approach numeric growth strategically and intensely.

#### 9. Prayer

Prayer is a direct line to God. We as a church want to connect with God in prayer as we seek out living our J10 life. We will do this a group and individually.

The leadership advisors are responsible for holding the Sr. pastor accountable and helping him set the vision and direction of the church.

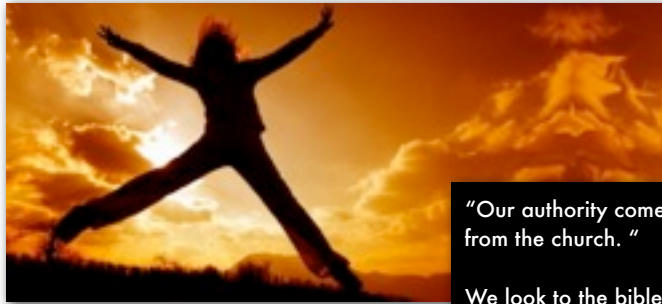

## What we believe

### 1. Primary Theology –

These are the core beliefs of the church. You can read more about them below.

### 2. Secondary Theology –

These are the beliefs that as a church we won't define ourselves by or even let them divide us. For instance, J10 is not a charismatic church (practice healing, speaking in tongues or other “gifts of the holy spirit”) We support others that believe in these aspects. However, we ask that they don't become a part of our church gatherings, groups, or events.

There is one true God, the creator and ruler of the universe, who eternally exists in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The Bible is the inspired word of God. It is the supreme source of truth for Christian beliefs and living, and the final authority for all matters of faith.

Every person has worth as a creation of God, but that all have sinned and can only be redeemed through accepting the gift of God's grace.

Forgiveness of sins and the promise of eternal life are available to those who trust Christ as Savior and Lord.

Those accepting Christ in faith should repent of sin, confess their faith, and be baptized into Him.

The Holy Spirit is at work in the world to make people aware of their need for Jesus Christ, and lives in every Christian from the moment of salvation.

The church is the body of Christ on earth, empowered by the Holy Spirit, and exists to love people into a relationship with Jesus Christ and develop them into maturity in Him.

Jesus Christ will one day return to earth and will reign forever.

We look to the bible to guide us. Our leadership makes decisions by what we read and understand in the scripture.

## WHAT WE PRACTICE

**BAPTISM** – The bible calls all adult believers to be baptized. If you are a believer and haven't been baptized your next step is baptism. Be sure to pick up the CD on baptism at the resource table. **COMMUNION** – Every week at J10 we remember the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. We typically do this after the message so that we can reflect on why we can make the life change the message just challenged us to make. The communion represents God's love for us. Some say they don't want to take it every week because it may get old. Let me ask you a question, “Do you limit the times you tell your wife you love her, so that it doesn't get old?”

# L2F

One of the greatest ministries is L2F (life to the fullest) lead by Jill Hills. L2F is a group of people that want to serve the Ashburn community. We have been Blessed and want to serve God by bringing His Blessings to others. We are not giving to receive, we are giving because Jesus asked us to give and serve others. - 2000 – New Life Christian church in Chantilly, VA launched the Dulles Campus.
- May 2005 – Mike Eppes came on staff to New Life as a church planter in resident.
- January 2007 – Mike’s resident program was over. The leadership of New Life asked Mike to take the Dulles campus and replant it as an independent thriving church to make a lasting affect in the Ashburn/Sterling area.
- Easter 2008 – The Dulles campus name was changed to J10 church and had it’s first service
- October 2008 – J10 had it’s grand opening and was officially an independent church with independent leadership and vision.
